THE FACULTY OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING English-medium Studies

General Information

- 1) All students must take 180 credit hours of a foreign language before successfully completing their programme of study. This can be accomplished by choosing either 30 or 60 semester hours.
- 2) Foreign language courses are incorporated in the model curriculum of studies for semesters 3, 4 and 5. Students, however, may choose to attend a language course in any semester, from semester 1 onwards.
- 3) International students may choose courses of Polish or of any other foreign language.
- 4) Polish students may also choose courses in foreign languages other than English.
- 5) Students of the third and higher semesters are required to pass the B2 level examination in any foreign language before successfully completing their study programme.
- 6) All students (both Polish and International) admitted to the Faculty in the academic year 2013/2014 must pass the English exam at C1 Academic level before successfully completing their study programme.
